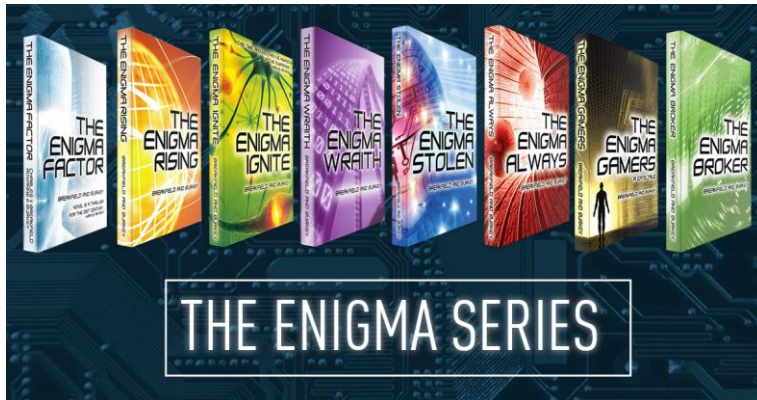

1. Burkey's stepfather was a metallurgist who worked on The Manhattan Project and later became a major contributor to the Atomic Energy Commission which was later renamed.
